While we should be appreciative all year long, it is school board recognition week from January 30th – February 5th. It is not an easy period of time to be a board member, but our group has done a great job of focusing on the students. It has been couple of very busy months for the board as they have hired a new superintendent, continued the school improvement process, and are working toward consideration of a project to expand and update our facilities.

The school board has hired Mr. Jeremy Klein, superintendent of Logan View Public Schools, as the new superintendent at Heartland for the 2022-23 school year. We appreciate the work and time committed to the process by many on staff and in the community in completing this process. I personally congratulate Mr. Klein and am committed to make his transition to Heartland a smooth one.

The board has also worked with the Nebraska Association of School Boards to work through a process of analyzing our district to develop goals for improvement over the next few years. They have surveyed and engaged students, staff, parents, and patrons in this process.

At the February meeting, the board will consider a resolution to call for a public vote for expansion and updates to our facility. There have been numerous meetings to share information and gather input to this process and much of that information may be found on our website. We are in a position to make necessary changes while still remaining the lowest taxing district in the area by nearly 10 cents on the levy. Please reach out if you have any questions.

As we move into the second half of our school year, we continue to battle illnesses and the availability of substitutes to cover classes for ill staff. If you have ever considered becoming a substitute teacher, please give us a call. We also appreciate your help in monitoring your student wellness and keeping them home when in doubt. We will get through this together.
